## **Our Second Jewish-Greek Conference**

For he is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; to make in himself of two one new man, so making peace; And that he might reconcile both to God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:  
*Ephesians 2:14-16*

Our Second Jewish-Greek Unity Event was an enormous blessing for the Greek believing community. We are encouraged as we continue with the vision to unite our two specially called nations: To the Jew first and also to the Greek. Our ultimate goal is to see revival fires burn in this Bible region once again as it was in the days of the first believers and moreso as we approach the Day of the Lord.

Our first evening was a Sabbath meal and teaching. The room was filled to capacity. Unfortunately 60 people were on a waiting list and were unable to join us. There was literally no place to put them! So next year we will have to gather in a larger facility. Our vision is touching more people and it is growing not just in numbers but also in substance. I translated a number of Hebrew songs into Greek so that we could sing in both Hebrew and Greek and it was historical to hear the two Bible languages lifted up together in praise to God! The teaching was rich and the believers are deepening in their knowledge of God's End time purposes for Israel and also for Greece. Yeshua is making us one new man.

Dan and Patty Juster came from Jerusalem and touched the Greek believers as they presented an offering to the Macedonian Church in reciprocity for what their forefathers had done 2000 years ago for the poor Jewish saints in Jerusalem.

Moreover, brethren, we want you to know of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia; How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded to the riches of their liberality. For to their power, I bear record, yes, and beyond their power they were willing of themselves; Praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints. And this they did, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and to us by the will of God. *2 Corinthians 8:1-5*

How amazing to see the equality unfold that the Apostle Paul prophesied to the Macedonian Greeks. For I mean not that other men be eased, and you burdened: But by an equality, that now at this time your abundance may be a supply for their want, that their abundance also may be a supply for your want: that there may be equality: *2 Corinthians 8:13-14*

I also was amazed to see all the seekers and new believers that I have shared the gospel with attend the conference. They all stepped into a non-orthodox Church for the first time and desired to learn about God's purpose for Israel and Greece. This was also a confirmation to me that we are on the right track with the vision to unite Jewish and Greek believers, for when we become one, God reveals His love and purpose in sending Yeshua in a special way, revealing His love for the world.

That they all may be one; as you, Father are in me, and I in you, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that you have sent me. And the glory which you gave me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and you in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that you have sent me, and have loved them, as you have loved me. *John 17:21-23*

The plane to Israel was packed with Israelis. I shared the gospel with a number of people, particularly a young man who very diligently wrote down all the scripture passages I gave him and hugged me before getting on the plane saying, "if I don't see you again, I hope I will see you in heaven." The Israeli couple that sat next to me on the plane were open the entire length of the flight to speak about Yeshua. Amazing! This is happening all over the place with both Jews and Greeks!

Here in Jerusalem, I experienced a strong anointing as I prayed in Greek over the Jewish believers and the nations who gathered to celebrate Sukkot together! I sensed that this was prophetic as Greece will once again play her role as a bridge nation, uniting and expanding the Jewish revelation of God to the nations. I have been meeting with the team and leaders from Tikkun/Revive for prayer, seeking the Lord for the next steps of our vision to see Israel and Greece become one in Yeshua and for revival. We are sure that this region will come into her full destiny and that His great light will break through and shine upon this region once again, in spite of the gross darkness that is filling the earth. Our Lord will finish what He began in both the Old and New Covenant cities and together we will see His glory!
