## **The Prayer is The Power**

When I was in Bible School in the 1980s, I took a course in the Book of Acts. Through this powerful Book, the Lord gave me 3 principals that have been keys to abiding in the Lord and living a supernatural life.

1. The Promise is the Prayer
2. The Prayer is the Power
3. The Power is the Proclamation (*Program*)

Although I attended Bible School, I soon realized that God's power is not released and maintained by taking a course in preaching, but by abiding in Him. The disciples of Yeshua did not ask Him to teach them how to preach, but they asked Him to teach them how to pray! As they walked alongside Him, they observed how He spoke to the people, cast out demons, healed diseases with all authority. They saw that He was a simple Man who simply spoke of His oneness with the Father. They knew that His authority came from this oneness and not from man and they desired to be just like Him.

As I imitate Yeshua by maintaining this oneness in God, I find that something supernatural always happens! Recently, we had some Israeli friends visiting us and after praying/worshiping in the morning, the Lord literally told me to go to a particular mountain spot near Thessaloniki in the evening to have a Shabbat meal. As we went, the Lord steered us away from several tavernas until we got to the cozy little one He was pointing to.

After our meal, I began to ask the owner questions about the Holocaust memorial across the street where 150 local Greeks, mostly women and children, were cast into the baker's oven alive by the Nazis who were combing the hills around Thessaloniki seeking partisan fighters from the Greek underground. The Nazis went from village to village and when they failed to find any partisans, they rounded up all the village people and slaughtered them all mercilessly. As this restaurant owner was telling us the details of his own family members who were cast into the baker's oven, he cried out, "we can never forget and we can never forgive!"

At that point, we were all with tears in our eyes and Sylvie, my German administrative assistant, instantly rose up from her chair, fell on her knees and began to plead with him for forgiveness for her people. "T" was shocked and broken, lifted her up from the ground and embraced her with tears! The rest is history. ... "T" not only received prayer and the Bible but has become our friend. He is reading the word, his heart is healed and he is free from the prison of unforgiveness. All this because we stayed in God's promises, abided in prayer and the power of the Holy Spirit led us to proclaim liberty to one wounded soul. Not a man's program, but the heart of God in action through our union with Him.

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD has anointed me to preach good tidings to the meek; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them who are bound. *Isaiah 61:1*

I want to encourage you to maintain your oneness in Him through the Holy Spirit. Believe and expect the power of the Lord to be released to you and through you. His power will be your proclamation and like Yeshua, you will be doing the very works of the Father who dwells within you.

I so appreciate you and bless you. May you know Him more and more in intimate union, doing the good works which He prepared for you from the foundations of the world. Thank you so much for standing with me. You are precious co-laborers in Christ.
